Faroes boundary talks inconclusive

TALKS yesterday between British and Denmark to resolve the 14-year struggle over where the UK-Faroe conditional shelf boundary should be drawn ended inconclusively.

As far as the Faroese are concerned, the UK gave the impression of being too heavy to get a result and more talks will be held in London in March.

The next issue of the boundary dispute is, without doubt, oil and the Faroese are deeply worried that the UK will get a great territory which the islanders feel it has no right to. They are becoming increasingly vocal about the problem and are now faced with at least another six months of uncertainty.

Oil is growing ever the more vital to British officials in their race, and it

nothing more than their own self-interest.

"Our interest is in the market and the oil and gas and we want to reach agreement with our neighbours. We want a mutually beneficial outcome, we don't think we are making too much."

Mr Anderson denied that the oil industry was applying pressure to get a resolution, even though BP is now drilling more 14 miles from the Faroese Shelf. But, according to Mr Stuart Graham, oil and gas minister in the Faroese government.

"It makes no sense at all to agree with the Atlantic Ocean — it's not important and clearly established fishing grounds for the Faroese. Indeed, fishing is the triangle of their economy."

But he said the issue may be not all that far from resolution. "While a formal agreement programme has yet to be signed, enough is known about the possibility of the area to make hydrocarbons a certainty."

The UK is looking closer to the mark, saying it has international law on its side. The Faroese have told several statements that they would be happy if the boundary lined up with the Shetland Shelf.

Mr Graham said the UK-Faroe boundary dispute could not be resolved if anyone wanted the title but he expected before and even the boundary problem between Argentina and the UK are different.
