Several Faroe subcontractors

As the time is now nearing for the next Faroe well exploration drilling, it can be confirmed that several Faroe subcontractors will be involved with the drilling project. Statoil has, as it has done in the previous drilling operations in 2001 and 2006, strived to use Faroe subcontractors to the extent this is possible. This means that the companies Atlantic Airways, Thor, Atlantic Supply Base, Effo and Magn will be very busy over the coming months, by servicing the Brugdan 2 well drilling operation. Last Friday, Statoil, which is the operator for this the deepest and most expensive well ever drilled in Faroe waters, gathered all the projects Faroe subcontractors together with the foreign subcontractors, such as the drilling company Cosl, the major oil industry subcontractors Halliburton and Transocean, to go through the whole drilling process in detail, together with people from Statoil.
