Faroese scouting trip to Greenland in April

Over the days of the 15th to the 19th of April, the Faroe Employment Association is organising a business trip to Greenland and the Faroe PM, Mr Kaj Leo Johannesen has announced his participation. The agenda for the trip has not yet been finally agreed, but the intention is to organise joint events, with an informative slant on the Greenland business/industrial structure to be conveyed to the participating Faroe companies and also vice versa. Business to business meetings will also be scheduled where the companies will have direct contact with one another. A stopover in Iceland is also planned, with a visit to the massive Alcoa plant on the agenda. The price for participation is quite steep, with a preliminary price of D.kr 17.000 per person for association members being quoted. Non-members will pay D.kr 19.000 per person. The prices quoted are however subject to the support of the Industrial Promotion Fund being gained for the project. The number of seats available for this trip is limited and therefore members of the Employers Association and their subcontractors will be accepted first over non-members.
